

# 10 Days Safari Tour of Uganda





**HIGHLIGHTS** Gorilla trekking, Game drives, Boat ride and Rhino trekking.

## **Day 1**

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### **ARRIVAL ENTEBBE**

On arrival at Entebbe International Airport in Uganda and after finalizing the formalities, you shall be welcomed by your guide, who will then drive you to your hotel.

## **Day 2**

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### **DRIVE TO MURCHISON FALLS NATIONAL PARK**

After breakfast proceed to the next highlight of your memorable tour of Uganda. You will drive to the beautiful north-western Uganda Murchison Falls National Park. You will stop at the Ziwa Rhino sanctuary a wildlife project that was concerned with reintroduction of white Rhinos that were once declared extinct in the 80s. In the afternoon take a trip to the legendary Murchison Falls where you will drive to the top of the falls and take a walk on the edge of the gorge through which the Nile falls with a deafening roar about 43 feet deep.

## **Day 3**

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### **GAME DRIVE AND LAUNCHCRUISE ON THE RIVER NILE**

After an early breakfast, proceed for a game drive. This is a beautiful drive across savannah, Borassus Palm Forest and grassland down to Lake Albert where the Albert Nile heads north. Drive in the open African Savanna in search for Lions, Leopard, Hyena,

Buffalo, Elephant, Jackson Hartebeest. Oribi, Waterbucks, Uganda Kobs, and enjoy spotting various Bird species such as the Secretary Bird, Black Chested Snake Eagle, Tawny and Marshal Eagles Carmine and Swallow Tailed Bee- Eaters, and many more. In the afternoon, you will go for a boat ride up the Nile, to Murchison falls, whence the park derives its name. You will further enjoy these spectacular falls by hiking to the top. You will see where the Nile squeezes through a 7 meter gap and at the bottom bask Huge Nile Crocodiles.

## **Day 4**

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### **BOATRIDE TO THE NILE DELTA**

After an early breakfast, you will go for a boat ride to the Nile Delta. Another interesting but more placid activity through the extensive papyrus delta through which the Victoria Nile flows into Lake Albert. Here again there are plenty of animals and birds to see with an excellent chance of seeing the rare Shoebill. You will then have an evening game drive in the Park or alternatively have well as visit the Fishing Village in Wanseko or a community walk with a guide to see how people live there.

## **Day 6**

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### **CHIMP TREKKING IN KIBALE FOREST**

After an early breakfast, you shall proceed to Kibale forest for chimp trekking. This NP ist famous about the different monkeys and hast he biggest population of Chimps. The trekking is generally a 2-4 hr walk in the forest and will include an hour with the wild community of chimpanzees that we have.

Afternoon you can make a swamp walk to see different monkeys.

## Day 8



### DRIVE TO BWINDI GORILLA TREKKING

This morning you will get up very early for the gorilla trekking. Trekking the Mountain Gorilla is one of the most exciting wildlife experiences on earth. The trek will take between 2 and 6 hours, but is well worth the effort. You will be led by an experienced ranger who will tell you interesting facts about flora and fauna and the lifestyle of the Gorillas. As an alternative to gorilla

trekking, there are several walks that can take you. The Mubwindi Swamp Trail takes about 3 hours and goes through parts of the park where there are elephants. Another 6-hour hike leads up to the peak in Rwamunyoni to 2.607m.

## Day 9



### DRIVE TO LAKE MBURU NATIONAL PARK

Today, drive to Lake Mburo National Park. Even at the entrance to the park you can watch impalas and zebras. You will have a game drive as you enter the park. The Lake Mburo National Park forms a mosaic-like habitat with rocks, dry slopes, open and wooded savannas, forests, and swamps increases. This

diversity of habitats has the diversity of bird life with 313 bird species recorded in the park, including flame head Barbet, Long-tailed Zitting Cisticola (Tabora), African Bins Rail, Collared Barbet, binding Bush singer among others.
